SHE_SEES A pioneering exhibition spotlighting inspirational stories of women in the maritime industry is coming to Portsmouth. Launching on Friday 2 August, visitors to Boathouse 4 in Portsmouth Historic Dockyard will be able to experience the free, thoughtprovoking SHE_SEES exhibition, which is spearheaded by global safety and education charity Lloyd's Register Foundation. The exhibition blends visuals, art and storytelling, with portraits of inspiring women, including local examples. Hosted in partnership with Portsmouth Historic Quarter and the University of Portsmouth, it taps into archive materials from the UK and Ireland to uncover the history of trailblazing female voices in the industry, and aims to change the tide on diversity.
